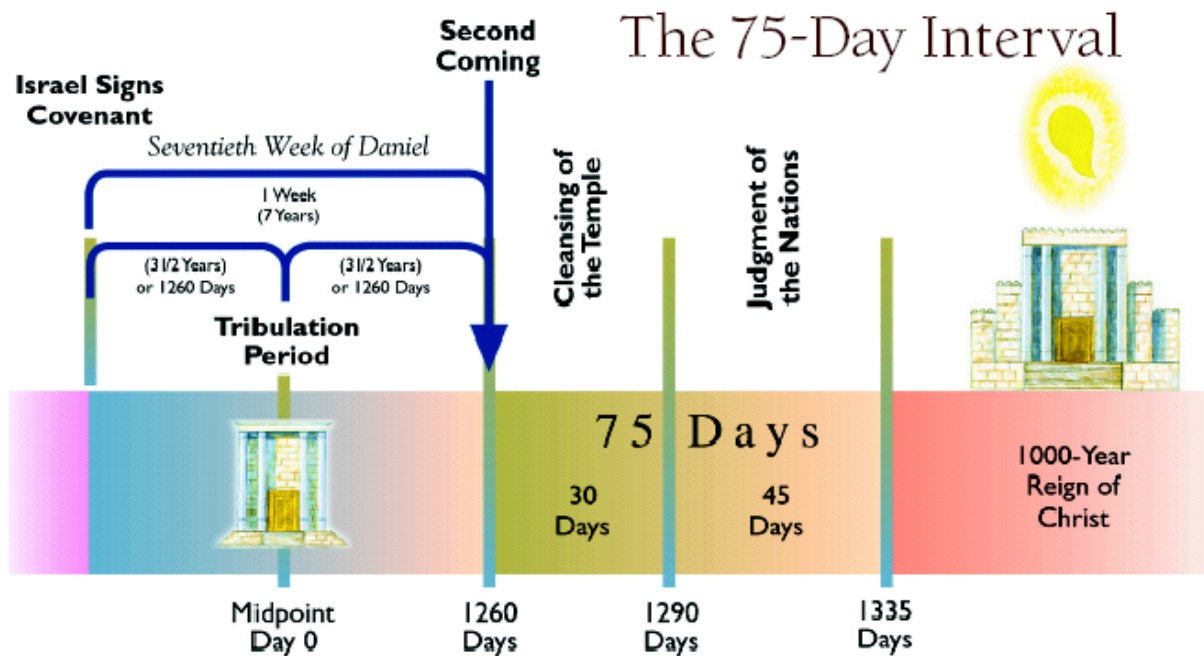

Preparation for the Millennium

75 Days and Judgment

Daniel 12:7-12 indicates that there will be a 75-day interval between the second coming of Christ to earth and the start of the 1000-year Millennial Kingdom.

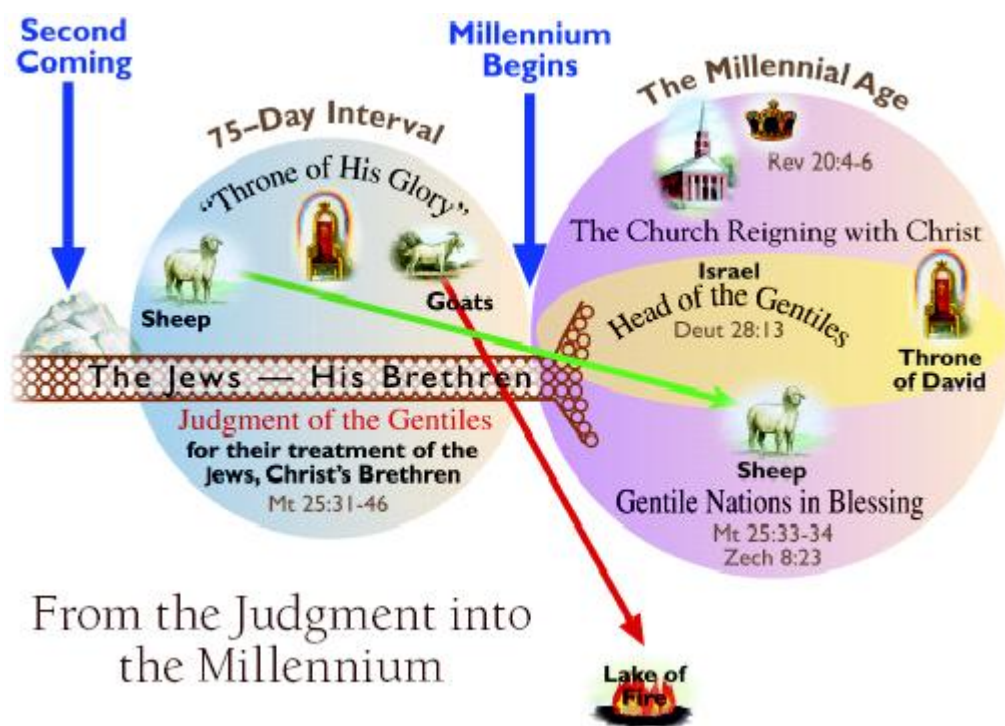


The 1260-day period or precisely forty-two months of thirty days each, can be regarded as culminating with the Second Advent itself. This is followed by several divine judgments (discussed next). These great judgments beginning with the living on earth and purging out of unbelievers who have worshiped the beast, although handled quickly, will require time. By the 1,335 days or seventy-five days after the Second Advent, these great judgments will have been accomplished and the millennial kingdom formally launched.

Those who survive to the end of the Tribulation and aren't cast into punishment by Christ will all be believers. Jesus, in the Olivet Discourse, said **“But the one endures to the end, he will be saved”** (Matt 24:13). The word “saved” in the Greek text translates as “delivered,” which means those who endure the frightful events of the Tribulations will be delivered if they survive the judgment of the nations described by Jesus in Matt: 25:31-46.

There are a few judgments that happen at the Second Advent of Jesus:

- The re-gathering and judgment of Israel (Ezek. 20:34-38).
- The judgment of the gentile nations (Matt. 25:31-46).
- The Beast and False Prophet are judged (Rev. 19:20).
- The participants of the Campaign of Armageddon (Rev. 19:21).



Those who attain to the period of 1,335 days are those who have been judged worthy by Christ and will hear from Him **“Come, you who are blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world.”** (Matt. 25:34)
